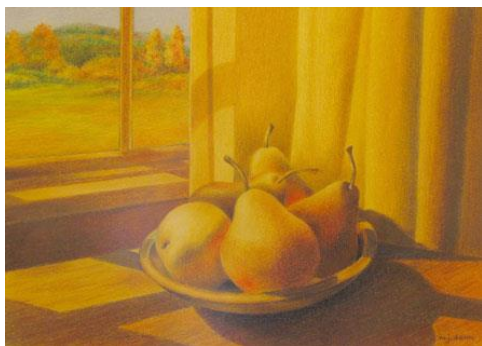




A \$400 Shrewsbury Cultural Coalition grant AGS was given.
